First Aid for Poisoning



Has the person collapsed or stopped breathing?

Call **911** or your local emergency number right away.



Poison in the eyes?

Rinse eyes with warm running water for 15 to 20 minutes.

Call **1-800-222-1222**.



Poison on the skin?

Take off any clothing that the poison touched. Rinse skin with running water for 15 to 20 minutes.

Call **1-800-222-1222**.



Inhaled poison?

Get to fresh air right away.

Call **1-800-222-1222**.



Swallowed the wrong medicine or too much medicine?

Do not give anything by mouth.

Call **1-800-222-1222**.



Swallowed something that's not food or medicine?

Drink a small amount of milk or water.
